

MATH NOTEBOOK GRADING POLICY

Your Interactive Math Notebook is an important tool for learning. As such, it will be graded in a few different ways.

- I will check it about once a week to make sure your notebook is neatly done, organized, with accurate information, and all the required elements are up to date.
- I will also grade some lessons completed in the notebook to check for understanding and/or mastery of the topic.
- At the end of each grading period, you will turn in your Interactive Math Notebook for grading using this rubric.

If you earn 10 or less out of 16 points, you will have to conference with me to make a plan for improving so that you can make your Interactive Math Notebook an effective tool for learning. This plan will need to be signed by your parents and included in your notebook. As long as you follow the guidelines, my instructions, and ask questions when you're not sure of something, you will always earn good grades with your Interactive Math Notebook!
